# Call for Nominations

All ASA retired members are eligible to serve two-year terms on the ORN Advisory Board. Members communicate via email; generate ideas for the organization; help to organize our annual Life in Sociology presentation, panel and workshop sessions; and meet at the annual business meeting and reception held during ASA's Annual Meeting. The term of service is September 2019 through August 2021. Candidates will be placed on the ASA ballot for the 2019 election. Nominations are due no later than December 31, 2018.

#### Revised ByLaws Submitted to ASA Council

Proposed revisions to the current **ORN bylaws** were approved at the ORN business meeting in August. The proposed revisions, including a name change from ASA Opportunities in Retirement Network to ASA Retirement Network, will be reviewed by ASA Council at its March 2019 meeting. If approved, a formal vote of the revised bylaws will be included on the spring 2019 ASA ballot, along with the election of new advisory board members.

## ORN Sessions Held During ASA Annual Meeting in Philadelphia Very Successful

We held three excellent sessions at this summer's Annual Meeting. Our "Life in Sociology" lecturer was Carroll L. Estes, Emerita Professor of Sociology at the University of California-San Francisco.
